Boom Lift License Port Coquitlam - Only fully licensed individuals must operate an aerial boom lift. Qualification could be obtained through a combination of sessions in the classroom and practical training with the specific kind of aerial lift that would be used on the job. A License is required for anybody who operates or works on an aerial boom lift.

Vehicle-mounted aerial devices comprise the following work vehicles: extensible boom platforms, aerial ladders, vertical towers, articulating boom platforms, and whatever combination of these kinds.

When making use of a boom lift, there are a few basic safety rules that apply to all boom lifts. Safety of the worker is a top priority while they are working in the basket. The worker should at all times have on a body harness and lanyard, connecting it to the basket or boom. Never tie off to an adjacent pole, structure, or equipment. Employees must stand on the basket floor, and never climb or sit on the basket edge. The manufacturer's load restrictions must be adhered to.

Lift operators need to be certified to operate an aerial lift. The manufacturer's manual must be kept within the lift and the operator has to know all aspects of that particular unit. Operators are responsible for ensuring that safety measures are followed in operating the lift. A daily test of lift controls must be done. Position outriggers and set brakes (if they are utilized) on pads or a stable surface. If working on a slope, utilize wheel chocks.

The aerial lift vehicle must never be moved whilst a worker is in the basket of an elevated boom, unless they are making use of machinery that are specifically designed for this. Extensible boom platforms and articulating boom made use of as employees carriers must have accessible, plainly marked, upper controls. Except for in emergency situations, lower controls must not be utilized to override upper controls unless the individual inside the lift gives authorization.

While working from an aerial lift, do not wear pole or tree climbers.

The insulated part of the aerial lift should not be altered.

Do inspect the booms to make certain that it is correctly cradled and the outriggers are in the stowed position prior to moving. When operating a boom lift next to power lines, make certain that the lines are di-electrically tested according to local regulations.
