### **Forklift Training Guidelines**

It is important that all workplaces utilizing forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural flaw that may cause accident, injury or damage to machine.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are alterations to daily lift truck schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) The forklift tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Are yearly inspections of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working properly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted right?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted correctly on the lift truck?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to use the equipment?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) Are forklift operators up to date on training for all types of lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Forklift operators know their duties to report the damage to the machine and other forklift incidences?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed daily prior to the equipment being utilized?
