Loader Training Port Coquitlam - Why You Should Complete A Loader Training Program - Any person who wants to operate a forklift needs to take a Loader Training course in order to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are several ways to obtain forklift training. Courses are offered through company forklift certification programs, workforce training agencies, and approved on line and video courses. The cost can be minimal (or free) when provided through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

Forklift operators should be 18 years of age or over, in most countries. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training programs and need operators to obtain a certificate before operating this kind of heavy machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Businesses that hire staff to drive forklift trucks could face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators could result in serious injuries and property damage because of improper use of the equipment. Training covers the proper loading and driving techniques. Employees have to pass a written exam to be able to be certified. A company will usually designate a supervisor in order to provide hands-on training to new employees. A certified supervisor should have extensive training in forklift safety and be trained as a trainer.
